Unfair Representation

- Church has done a poor job teaching and modeling this
 - Focused more on <u>prohibitions</u> and <u>dangers</u> than on the <u>beauty</u> and <u>joy</u> of God's design. (God is not cosmic kill-joy). Fear and threat is adequate for short-term change but for long-term change we have to believe that God's way is good, positive and valuable.

Two Views

- Cynical defensive and self-righteous, rather than winsome and humble towards those who hold different views about sexuality. Right to respect sexuality as something deeper but wrong to see no reason to be interested, or have joy about it.
- Carnal thinking shallowly (how to maximize physical pleasure) instead of deeply (embracing the full biblical view of sexuality) Right to see the joy and the reason to be interested but wrong to think so shallowly about it.

A Reflection of God!

"The Bible proclaims loudly that we are not merely animals, naked and bestial. Neither are we sexual simply on a physical, animalistic level. Theologically, there is a hidden purpose behind our creation as sexual persons. Understanding this hidden purpose helps us to do two things: value ourselves more and learn a positive way to handle sexual temptation. The good news is that our sexuality is not merely biological or bestial but instead is a reflection of God."

- Genesis 1:27 Male and Female Image of God Hebrew poetry.
 - analogy of relationship our sexuality displays our ability and inclination to be relating people. We've been created with an inborn ability and need to relate to others. Gives us a desire for intimacy.
 - Trinity is an example of this. It is therefore, when we love others and allow ourselves to be loved that we most reflect the image of God.
 - The Drive Toward Intimacy our sexuality is a positive tool used by God to prod us towards quality friendships, our sexuality is a gift from God that can help us develop true friendships.
 - We have a thirst for a "communion of souls" that motivates us to love in spite of fear of failure.
 - That is why sexual fulfillment cannot occur with porn., masturbation (while alone, not with spouse) strip clubs, cyber sex, novels, etc. Not satisfied by orgasm! You don't quite feel like you've scratched the itch.

Important Conclusions

- Human sexuality is essentially relational and spiritual
- True sexual satisfaction develops within a long-term relationship with your spouse
- True sexual satisfaction develops within a personal love relationship with God
- God's enemy deprives us from sexual fulfillment by twisting it into lust gratification
